NY Acquisition Formally Announced

In Press Release

The Chemung County Industrial Development Authority considered projects at today's regularly scheduled meeting. Public hearings will be held in each of the respective projects' municipality in the coming weeks.

One project that will move forward is Southern Tier Logistics, a subsidiary of Ohio Logistics, is now majority owner of "HOST Terminal" in the Village of Horseheads. It has a longterm strategy to convert the campus into a state-of-the-art logistics center with value added services. They are working on finalizing Foreign Trade Zone status for the center and have a seven-year investment plan totaling \$125 million starting with the construction of a 461,000 square foot, \$25 million warehousing facility that will be completed by January 2023. The building already has full tenancy commitment and will create 73 jobs. It has already completed demolition of several original buildings, leaving the original concrete pad foundations in place.

Ohio Logistics has 25 locations in six states and currently operates over 6 million-square-feet of warehouse space. It also has a transportation division. Together it is able to provide customized value-added services for their customers including custom packaging, light assembly, and logistics management. They have an efficacious track record of developing public private partnerships with the communities in which they are located.

The Chemung County Industrial Development Agency (CCIDA) is a Public Benefit Corporation of the State of New York that was formed in 1975 at the request of the Chemung County legislature. The Chemung County IDA consists of a sevenmember Board of Directors, each of whom are appointed by the Chemung County Executive and ratified by the Chemung County Legislature. The Chemung County IDA, if it so chooses and so long as a project is eligible, may provide a variety of tax incentives, financing, and/or related benefits to a broad range of projects that provide a positive economic impact within Chemung County

Jonathan Winters of Bellbrook, OH was an American comedian, actor, authon host, and artist. With a career spanning more than six decades, Winters appeared in hundreds of television shows and films. A descendant of Valentine Winters, founder of the Winters National Bank in Dayton, OH, the family's fortunes collapsed during the Great Depression. During his senior year at Springfield High School, Winters auts chool to join the U.S. Marine Corps and served two and a half years in the Pacific Theater during World War II. Winters' career started as a result of a lost wristwatch. Not able to afford a new watch, Winters entered a talent contest with first prize being a watch. 

Welcome to "Tech Talk," your inside source for all things IT. Terminal Servers, you prob-ably know them as "TS." But do you really know what they are and why we have them? Terminal Services is a component of Microsoft Windows that allows users to access applications and data on a remote computer via the network. Essentially, you are logging into a "virtual" system that shares resources with all users. One of the challenges of managing a large number of local computers is the inability to keep the locally installed applications up to date. This means every time an application needs to be updated, IT would have to perform the upgrade individually on over 500 PC's. By utilizing TS, it means everyone can log into the same machine, access the same applications and data and reduce the number of PC's requiring application updates to three.
