## Ohio Logistics Supports Honor Flight

All Vietnam Era Veteran Flight to Take Place on November 1st



Flag City Honor Flight (FCHF) was founded in 2010, and has flown 20 missions to visit the memorials in Washington, D.C. that honor our Veterans, their military service, and the sacrifices they made for America's freedom. Ohio Logistics has been a major supporter for the majority of these missions.

On November 1st, a very unique flight will take place. It is unique in several ways:

It is the first time FCHF has flown three times in one season.

It is the first time all Veterans on the flight will be from the Vietnam Era.

It is also the first time the entire flight is possible because of a single sponsor - Ohio Logistics.

There are currently over 400 Vietnam Veterans on the FCHF waiting list for the flight, including some who have been waiting over six years to fly. 87 Vietnam era Veterans will

be on the Ohio Logistics-sponsored flight on November 1st, each accompanied by their guardian.

"We're excited at the thought of addressing our Vietnam Veteran waiting list, and so grateful to our friends and supporters at Ohio Logistics for their generosity in making this a reality," says Bob Weinberg, FCHF President. "Without the sponsorship of Ohio logistics, this All-Vietnam Veteran Honor Flight would not be taking place," he adds.

"I had the opportunity as a teenager to meet and work with a Vietnam Veteran," says Chuck Bills, Ohio Logistics' CEO. "He shared his experiences and encounters during his service; emotional for him and frightening for me. His name was Robin Frey. I will never forget his struggles with being 'home,' the fear in his eyes and voice. I don't recall telling Robin 'Thank you.' Our family wants to tell all Veterans 'Thank you.'"

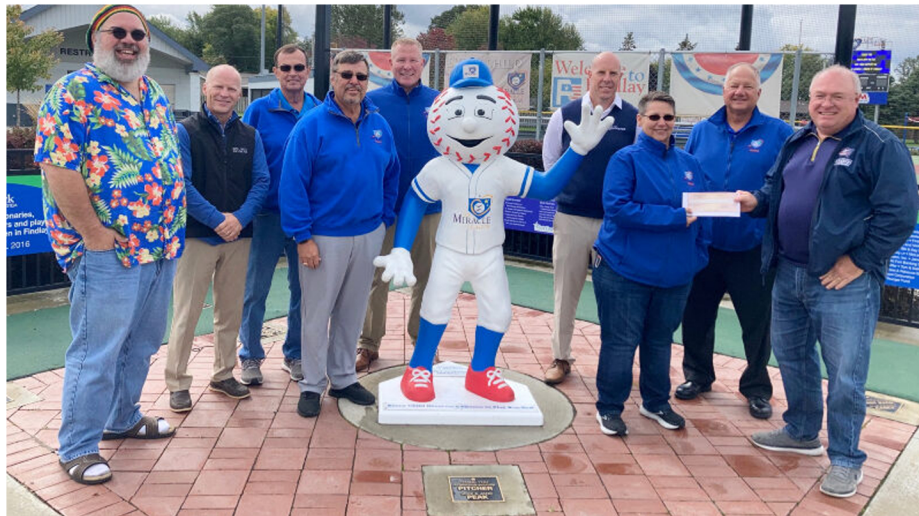

## Did You Know?

Replacing the tires on a semi-tractor and trailer is an expensive proposition. According to a leading industry insider, depending on use, the "steer" tires on a tractor last on average about 100,000 miles. To put new steer tires on a truck will run about \$500/tire (and there are two of them). The "drive" tires on a tractor can run for 200,000 miles and will cost about \$750/tire to replace with new (and there are eight of them). The eight trailer tires can also run about 200,000 miles, again, depending on use, and cost about \$400 each to replace with new. A little simple math tells us that a complete set of new tires for a tractor/trailer rig will cost about \$10,000. The good news is that it makes replacing your car tires sound a little less painful!

### Test Your Logistics IQ:

1) Motor carriers must have bodily injury and property damage insurance of not less than \$500,000 per incident per vehicle; higher financial responsibility limits apply for motor carriers transporting oil or hazardous materials.



2) Your company sells and ships to the distributor. The distributor sells and ships to the end user. This may occur in multiple stages. Ultimately, your product may pass through the Indirect/Distributor Channel and arrive at a retail outlet. Order information in this channel may be transmitted by electronic means. These means may include EDI, brokered systems, or linked electronic systems.

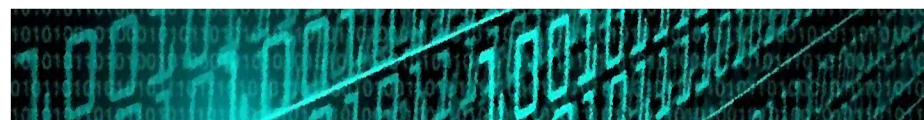


3) Principal direction of movement for customer orders which originate at point of demand or use, as well as other flows, such as return product movements, payments for purchases, etc. Opposite of downstream.

With the holidays quickly approaching and more people being out of the office, did you know that by going to Office.com you can access your Ohio Logistics email and OneDrive documents from anywhere there is an internet connection? Using your Ohio Logistics login credentials, you will be able to access Outlook for your emails, OneDrive for any documents you have saved to the cloud and even Word and Excel if you want to do a little work when you don't have access to your company computer. Are you a OneNote user? Yep, that's available also. Need to join a Teams meeting and you forgot your PC at work, no problem, Office.com allows you to access Teams right from the website. The Of-

fice.com portal was designed to allow users access to the entire Office suite of tools from anywhere in the world, securely and reliably.

Did you know: If you save something to your local hard drive, on your desktop perhaps, and you have a hardware failure or get hit with a virus, that data will be lost forever. Local machines are not backed up by IT. Make it a habit to save your documents to OneDrive where regular backups are part of the plan.

Missy: I hate scary movies, and I have seen all the episodes of Grey's Anatomy!

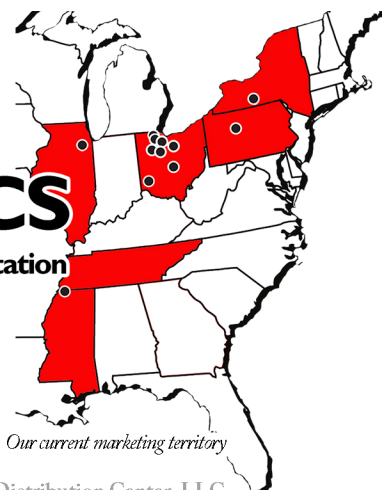

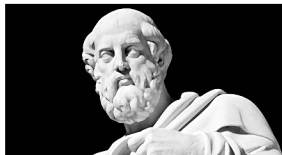
